

Journey to Dream Ambassadors

This volunteer level is “basic” meaning you do not need to complete the drug screen or driving record processes. These volunteers help Journey to Dream with daily operational tasks and office needs, including but not limited to:

- Community advocate volunteers who help speak to groups, spread the word about JTD at info booths during community events and more
- Office maintenance (building desks, hanging, changing light bulbs, painting, cleaning)
- School program supply packing
- Special Event committees (i.e. Gala Committee)
- Special Event volunteering (i.e. Shop with a Cop, Gala, Golf Tournament events)

Kyle’s Place Crew

This volunteer level is “advanced” meaning you must complete the drug screen. These volunteers support our teens and serve as their cheer family by attending athletic and/or extracurricular events for our students including games, choir concerns, and banquets (seasonal commitment)

Kyle’s Place Cabbies

This volunteer level is “advanced” meaning you must complete the drug screen and driving record processes. These volunteers help support JTD staff by transporting our residents to/from appointments, school, deliver donations to/from KP, etc.

Kyle’s Place Sparks

This volunteer level is “advanced” meaning you must complete the drug screen process and/or food handler certificate training. What is your spark? Share it with the residents...examples include:

- Life skill classes/teaching something you love; how to ...change a tire, sew a button, professional job skills, write an email, anything you would teach a young adult!
- Sharing something you love: Hair/nails/makeup, yoga, gardening, play sports, outdoor activities, animals, your career
- Cooking weekday dinner/dessert (requires food handler’s certificate)
- Academic tutoring

Dream Initiative Volunteers

These volunteers are at both "basic" and "advanced" levels meaning you must complete the drug screen or additional training for advanced roles. These volunteers attend school group sessions at various schools in and around North Texas during the school year (Sep-May, M-F, during school hours, 1 hour long)

- Basic– Assist JTD staff during school group sessions
- Advanced -Facilitate school group sessions along with JTD staff
